#### Students have the right, at appropriate times, to:

- Express their faith in class work and homework

- Express their faith at a school event or graduation ceremony
- Pray before meals, at free time, before and after school
- Wear shirts, jewelry, etc. with religious verses or symbols

- Students are intimidated, shamed or even disciplined for a protected expression of faith.
