Praying to Preserve Religious Freedom National Religious Freedom Day: Jan. 16, 2026

Jan. 16 is the date chosen for America's annual religious freedom observance because it was on Jan. 16, 1786 that the Virginia General Assembly adopted the Virginia Statute for Religious Freedom by Thomas Jefferson. This statute became the model for our Constitutional First Amendment's protection of individual conscience.

This prayer from the USCCB asks for the strength to preserve that natural right.

O God our Creator,

from your provident hand we have received
our right to life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness.
You have called us as your people and given us
the right and the duty to worship you, the only true God,
and your Son, Jesus Christ.

Grant, we pray, O heavenly Father,
a clear and united voice to all your sons and daughters
gathered in your Church
in this decisive hour in the history of our nation,
so that, with every trial withstood
and every danger overcome—
for the sake of our children, our grandchildren,
and all who come after us—
this great land will always be "one nation, under God,
indivisible, with liberty and justice for all."
We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.
